

Green tourism triangle










MAIN CLIMATE CHALLENGES IN TOURISM
















Barrier-free accessibility for all

- persons with a handicap
- persons with reduced mobility (PRMs)
- persons with functional limitations (PFLs)

- UN Charta for persons with disabilities
- proposed Directive on accessibility to products and services COM(2015)615

Conclusions

- EU methodology on robust certification of green labels
- support green SMEs, none for air/road travel, nor big hotel chains
- protection of cultural, natural, historical and industrial heritage as resources for green tourism
- promotion of EuroVelo combined with rail networks for soft tourism
- further development of barrier-free accessibility to tourism services (better regulation and coherence within existing EU legislation)
- review EU Treaty: integrate better balance EU actions subsidiarity
